A NEW 24-hour gym has now opened its doors to the public in Didcot.

Pure Gym has opened a new branch in the town, taking over an empty unit on Broadway.

The 'budget-friendly' fitness centre had its first visitors on Monday afternoon, enjoying the facilities which are available for a

small membership fee.

The gym is set over two floors and has changing rooms, studios and different workout zones, which are all open throughout the day and night.

Bosses of Pure Gym said they aim to 'help to significantly improve the provision of health and fitness facilities in Didcot and

therefore serve to promote healthier lifestyles'.

Didcot charity champion Andrew Baker, whose charity Play2Give has raised more than £100,000 for causes including Oxford Children's Hospital, was at the grand opening to officially cut the ribbon.
